HOW IT WORKS AT OUR AUCTION



THE MORE YOU DONATE IN KIND,
THE MORE YOU CAN SAVE ON TAX.

HOW THE TAX BENEFIT WORKS

When you donate, the amount is deducted from your taxable income. This means you pay less tax. The higher your tax bracket, the more tax you save for the same donation.

EXAMPLE: HOW A R10,000 DONATION WORKS

If you donate R10,000, you do not get the full R10,000 back. Instead, the deduction lowers your overall taxable income, and the "earning" or tax savings depends entirely on your marginal tax bracket.

Because high earners pay a higher percentage of tax, they save more money on their tax bill for the exact same donation amount.

	Annual Taxable Income	Your Tax Bracket	Tax Saved on R10,000	Effectively "Rebated" to You
1	R250,000	18%	$R10,000 \times 18\%$	R1,800 back
2	R500,000	31%	$R10,000 \times 31\%$	R3,100 back
3	R800,000	39%	$R10,000 \times 39\%$	R3,900 back
4	R1,500,000+	45%	$R10,000 \times 45\%$	R4,500 back

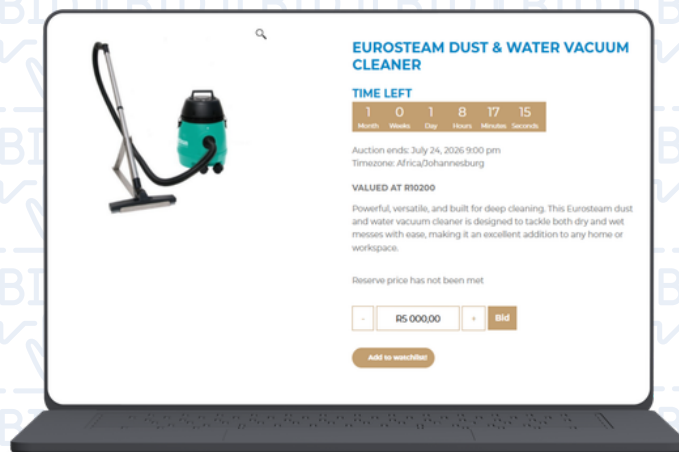
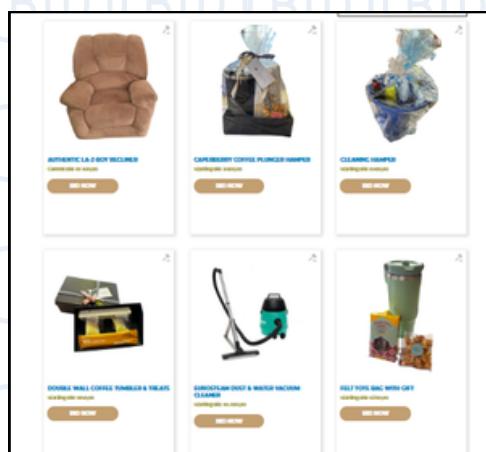

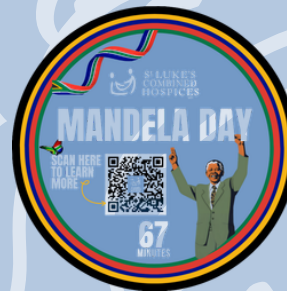
